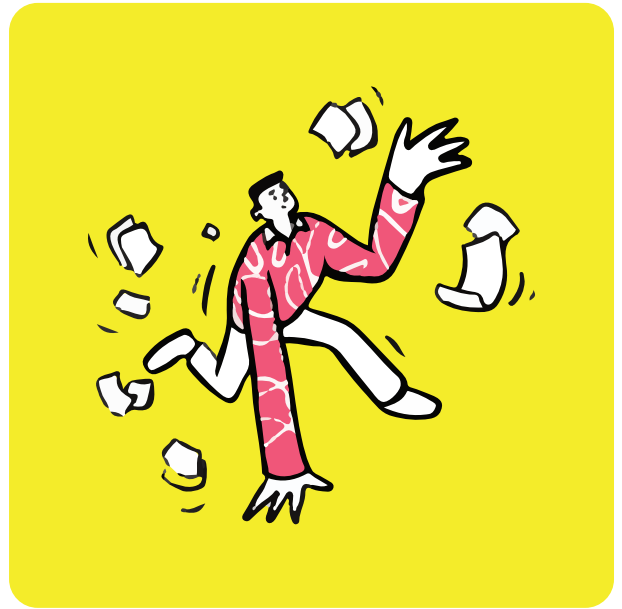


It is strictly individual.

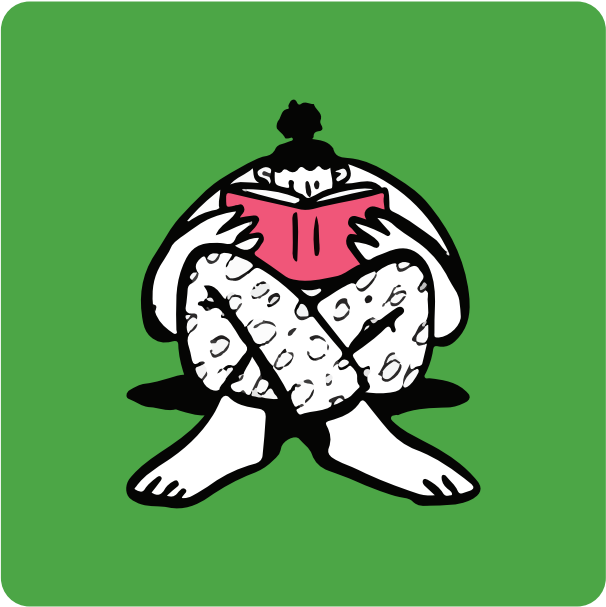

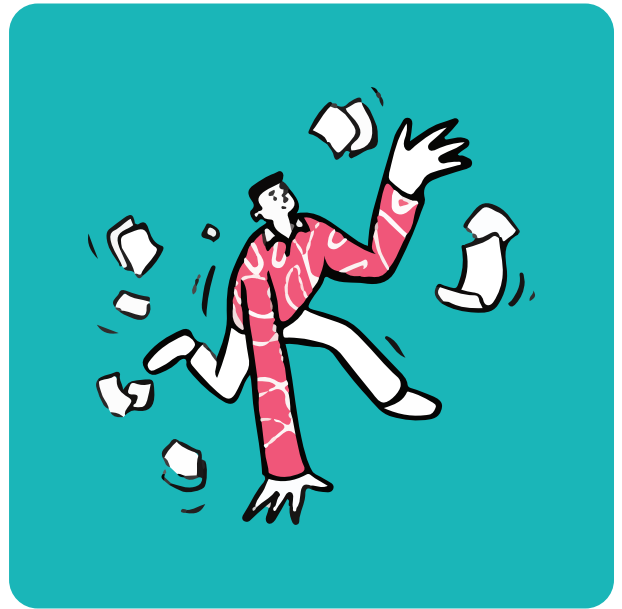


Explaining a concept, during interaction with students and for preparation of the lessons.

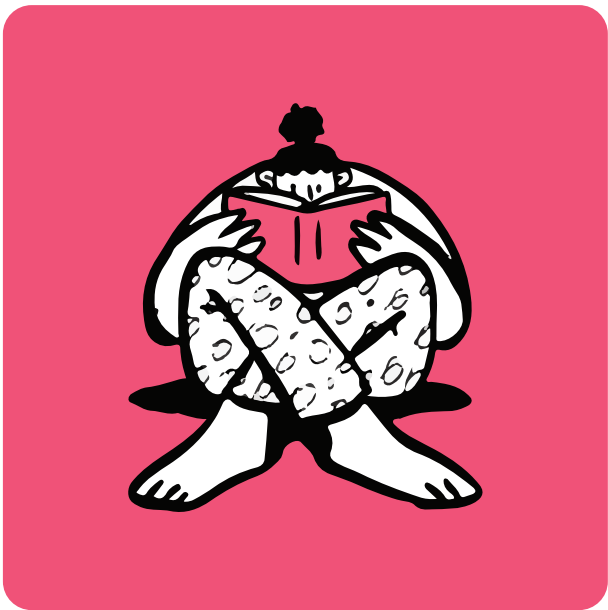
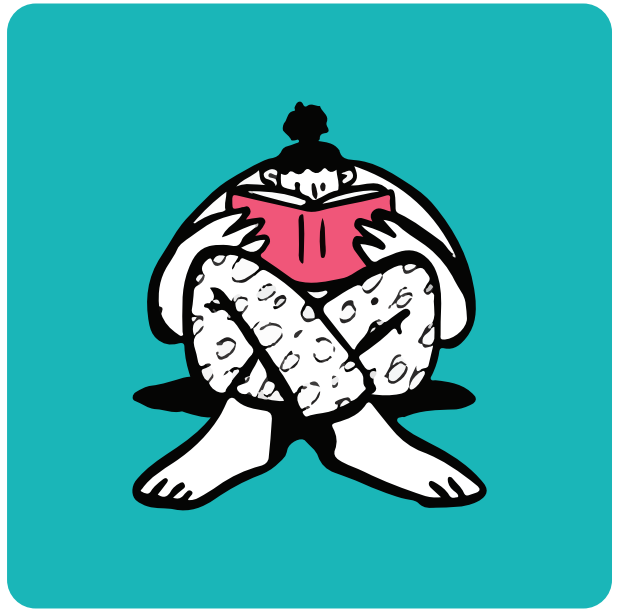
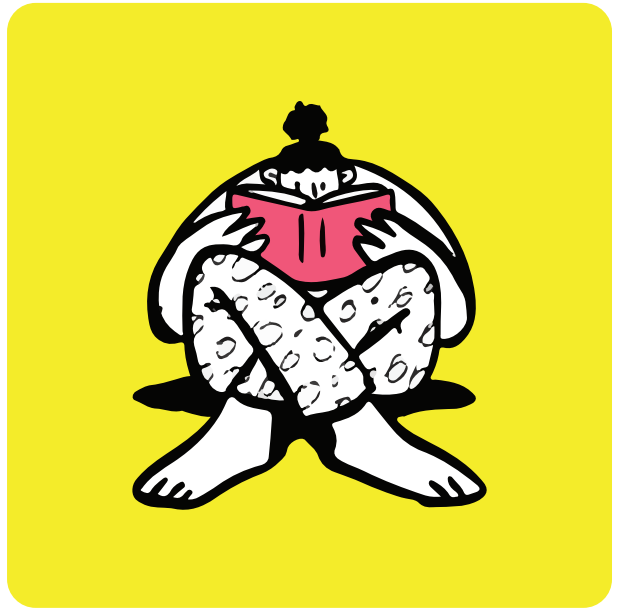
